Help with Tax Issues ▶

Free legal resources are available to help low-income families with tax-related problems from prior years. **To qualify, income needs to be below \$32,200 for individuals or under \$66,250 for a family of four.** Assistance can include helping respond to IRS audits, establishing payment plans, and other options.
