

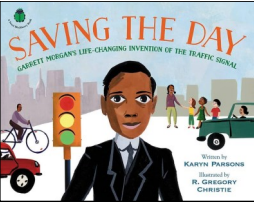
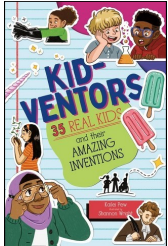

The more specific the topic, the more specific the number. For example, you can find nonfiction books about **inventions** in the **609.2s**.

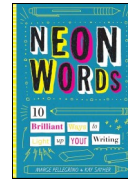
