

How Dewey find the books?

The Dewey Decimal System is a way to keep items in order by subject. It helps you find what you are looking for! In this system, books are numbered, from 000 to 999, and every topic has a number. The more specific the topic, the more specific the number. For example, you can find books about **video games** in the **794.8s**.

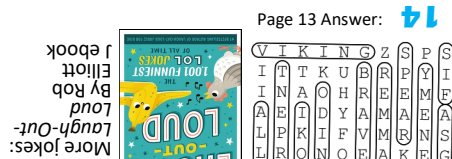
Free films at the Central Library in January! Free parking, too!

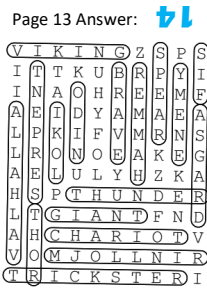

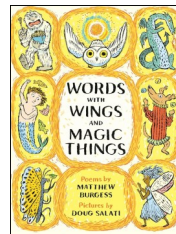
Gray

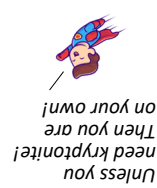
It was a gray day of nothing to say.

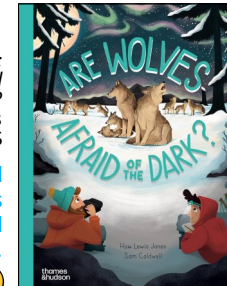

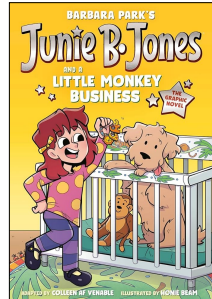
